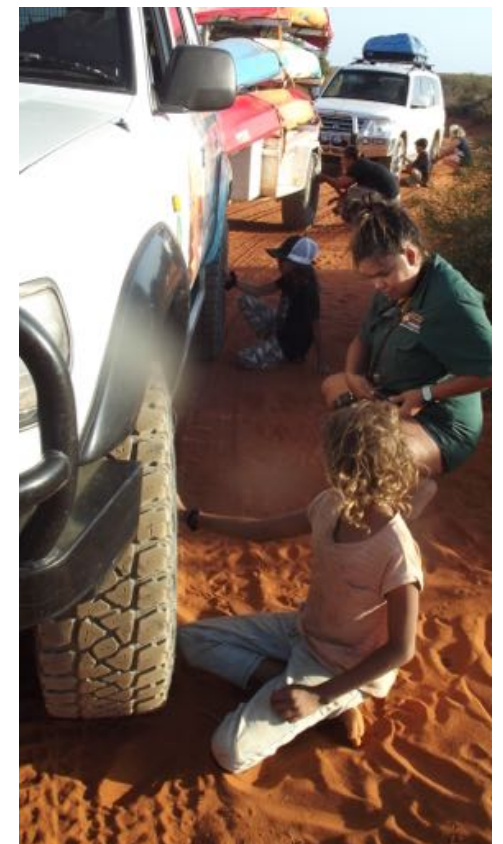




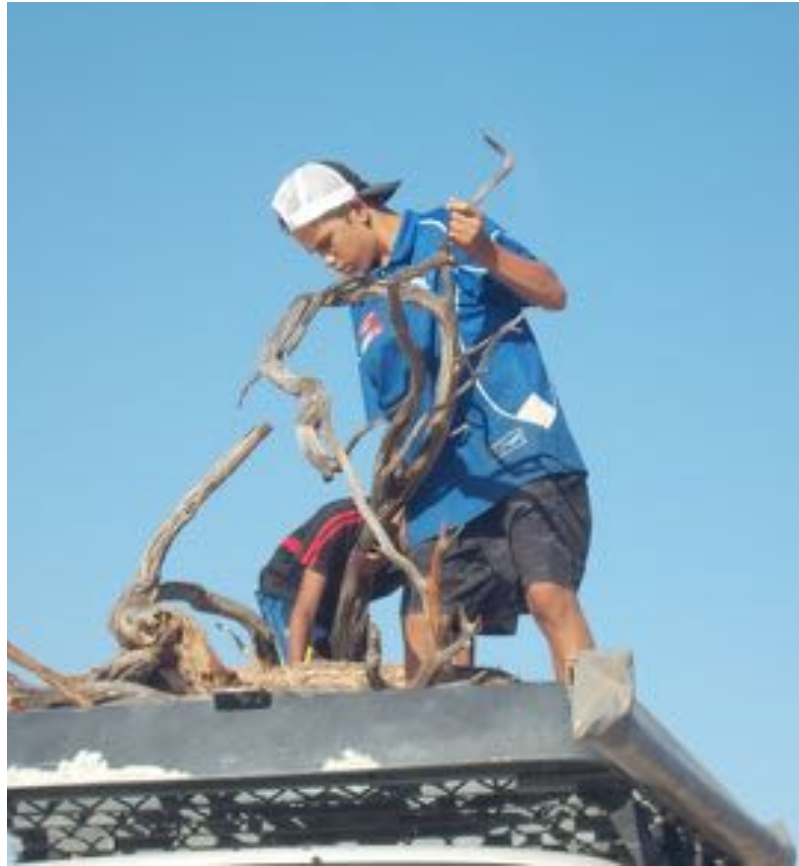

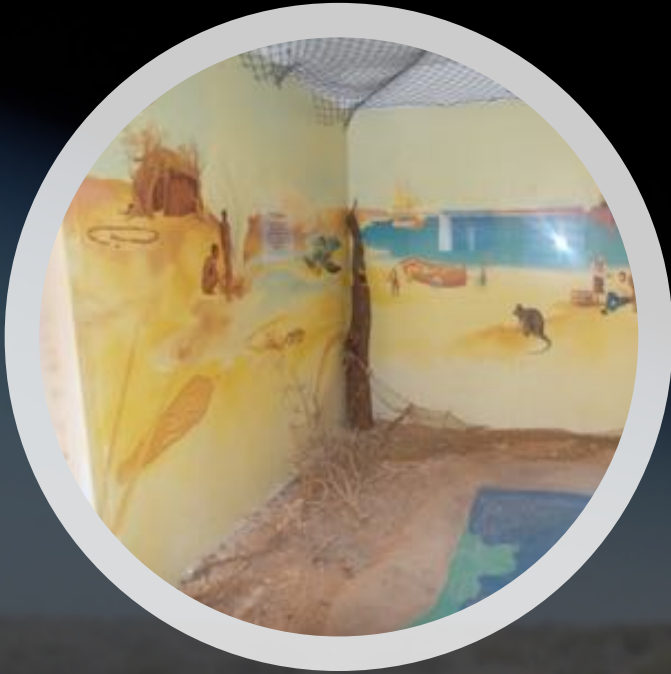

Beach walking, the old homestead museum and the shutter broke on the camera.

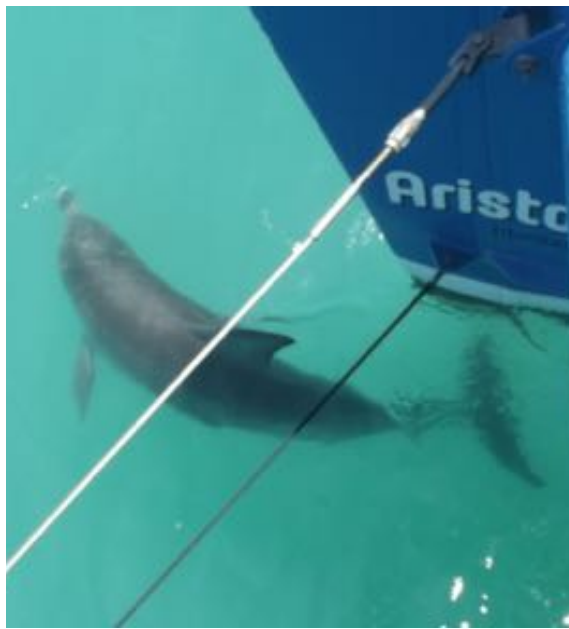
